

NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS

Water Price Increases Effective 1 January 2026

The Committee continues to manage the rising costs associated with operating and maintaining the Association's assets. Over the past year, we have completed significant upgrades, including replacing the old switchboard, upgrading the pump motors, and constructing a new salt chlorination plant. Work is ongoing to implement telemetry options to improve maintenance efficiency.

It remains essential that we maintain our reserves at a minimum of \$1 million to ensure we can respond to any adverse events, cover uninsured costs, and fund future upgrades or equipment replacements in the event of failures.

At the meeting held on 8 September 2025, the Committee resolved that the following pricing structure will take effect from 1 January 2026. The September and December 2025 quarterly readings will continue to be billed at the current rates.

Our pricing review considers overall member usage, applying a flat rate for smaller users and a revised discount structure for higher-use members.

The last water price adjustment took effect on 1 January 2024.

All amounts below exclude GST.
